"Only one oversized work vehicle or work trailer is permitted onsite per household outside of a fenced or garaged area. In accordance with Article VII, Sections 16 and 32, and the interest of the neighborhood look, feel, and home values, excess numbers of trailers and oversized vehicles will be subject to fines if

stored outside of a fenced or garaged area. The Gallatin Heights subdivision is a residential area in nature, commercial storage limitations are outlined under Article V, Section 3, Item 4e of the CC&Rs. Daily use of a vehicle or trailer does not nullify the limitation. In conjunction with Article VII, Section 32 regarding towing of vehicles, any oversized work vehicle or trailer parked on the street, obstructing traffic will be towed and fined, except in cases of loading and unloading, residential delivery of goods and services, or temporary parking (less than 90 minutes)."
